

# **Privacy Policy**

This Privacy Policy is intended to inform all users of the Quantum Leben AG (hereafter "QL") website about precautionary measures taken to protect their privacy when collecting, using, and communicating their personal information.

QL is not responsible for the content of any third party websites or their privacy practices. This Privacy Policy may be updated at any time. We therefore recommend that you regularly read this Policy in order to familiarise yourself with possible amendments or changes.

## **Data Transmission to QL**

Please note that the internet is generally not considered a secure environment and that data transmitted via the internet may be accessible to unauthorized third parties, which may lead to a non-intended disclosure of data, to changes in the transmitted content or to technical malfunctions.

## The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

# **Personal Information**

This Privacy Policy sets out our principles in respect to the protection of your data, in particular information such as name, address, date of birth, e-mail address, user behaviour, IP address, etc., which relates to an identified or identifiable natural person (hereinafter referred to as "personal data").

This Privacy Policy applies only to QL's website and under no circumstances to any third party websites, products or services, even if you may be directed to third party content via a link from QL's website. In this context, QL does not assume any responsibility for the content of any third party product or service website.



## Purpose & general legal basis

QL's website aims to inform you about our company, products and services. You can also contact us via the contact form or by sending an e-mail to the general e-mail address info@quantumleben.li listed below. The information provided, such as surname, first name, telephone number and e-mail address, will be stored by us in order to answer your enquiry. The information will be deleted as soon as it is no longer required, unless legal storage obligations require its continued (and possibly limited) storage.

By visiting QL's website and using QL's products and/or services, you explicitly agree to the collection and processing of your personal data. In addition to this, you also accept QL's General Terms and Conditions in their most current version.

#### Personal information collected

In principle, you can visit our website without directly disclosing to us who you are, because we do not conduct our own web analyses on our website and do not use any web analysis tool (i.e. such as google analytics). Thus, no evaluation of visitor and usage data takes place. Our web servers automatically store the information transmitted to us by your browser when you use QL's website for purely informative purposes.

Any personal data is only collected and stored if you contact QL using the contact form on the website or via e-mail. By sending the contact form or e-mails, you agree that QL may process and store the data disclosed therein.

### Cookies

No so-called "cookies" are used on our website - with the exception of technically necessary cookies.

In order to make it easier to understand, it should nevertheless be mentioned here that a cookie is a small text file that a website stores on your hard drive in order to make it easier for you to use a website and to tailor it to your needs. To do this, however, the text file sends certain information to the location that put the cookie.

# Access to personal data for third parties

If personal data are stored, those data will not be sold, rented or made available to third parties in any other way than described here. Personal data will only be passed on to state institutions and authorities within the framework of mandatory legal provisions.

# Management, storage and security of personal data

Data protection is important to QL and we take is seriously. Therefore QL uses technical and organisational security measures to protect the data we manage against accidental or intentional manipulation, loss, destruction or access by unauthorised persons. QL's security measures are continuously improved in line with technological developments.

Your data will only be stored on the web servers of our homepage operator in 9490 Vaduz, Liechtenstein.



Despite our technical and organizational measures to protect your data, we cannot guarantee absolute security. By using our website, our products, and services, you acknowledge that QL does guaranty the protection of your data and does not accept any liability in the event of accidental or intentional manipulation, loss, destruction or access by unauthorized persons. Regardless of this, QL naturally complies with its reporting obligations within the meaning of the GDPR.

## Your rights

In principle, you have the rights of information, rectification, erasure, restriction, data portability, withdrawal and objection. If you believe that the processing of your data violates the data protection law or your interest in data protection have otherwise been violated in any way, you can also complain to the supervisory authority. In Liechtenstein, this is the Data Protection Office ("Datenschutzstelle").

On request, QL will inform you in writing whether and which personal data about you are or have been processed by us (Art. 15 GDPR).
